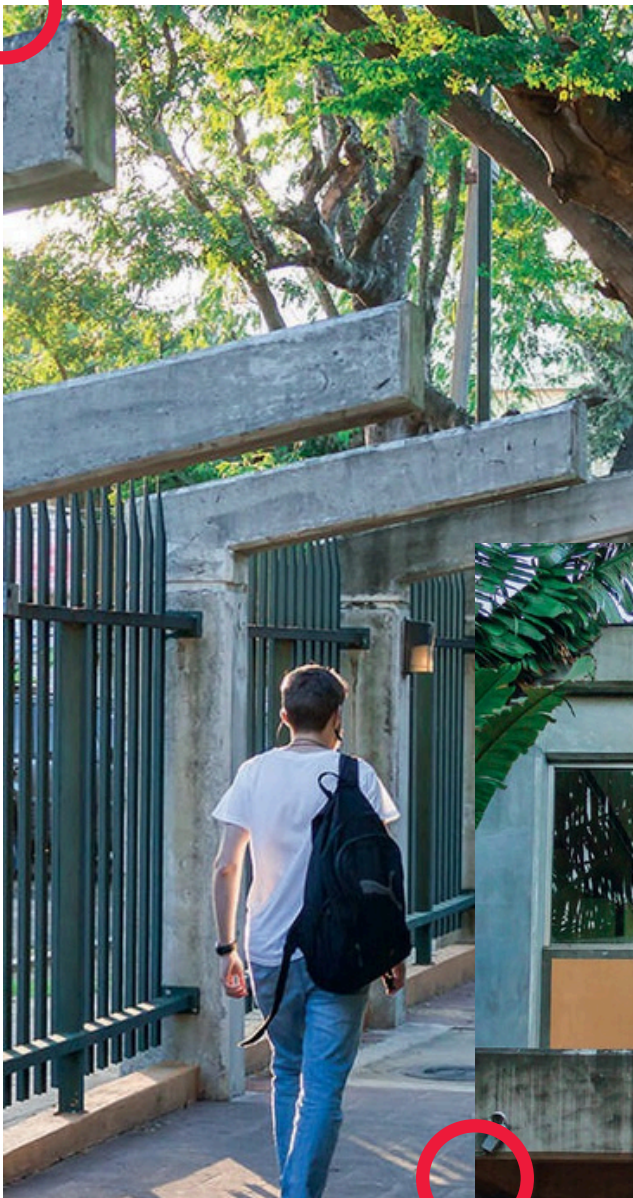

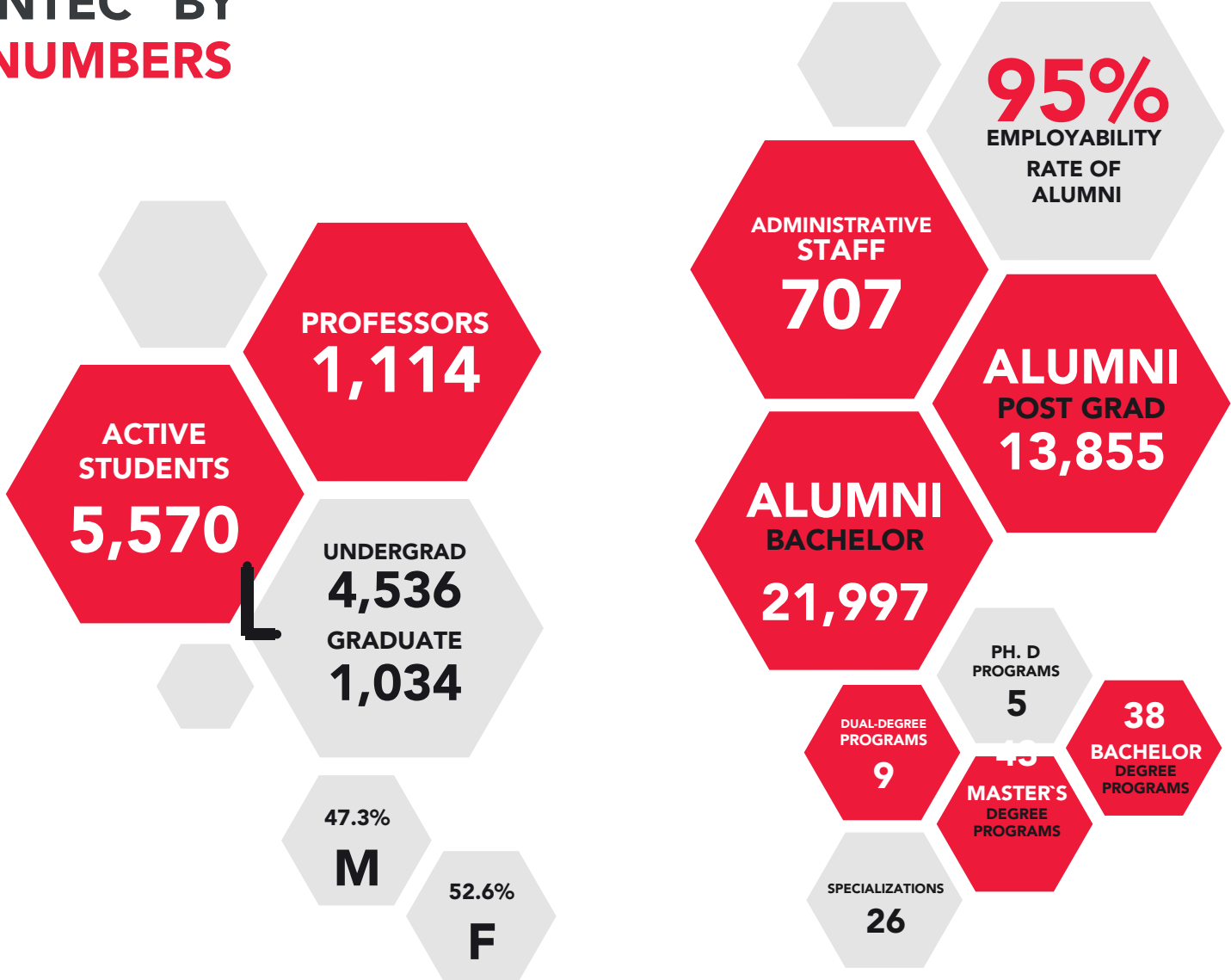

DOCUMENTS OF APPLICATION FOR STUDENTS



Complete the admissions process at

- Fill out the form GAC-FR-070 “Formulario de Solicitud de Movilidad para Estudiante Entrante”.
- Letter of nomination/presentation from the applicant's home university accrediting them as an active student and their official selection to participate in the program, signed by the head of the Studies/Mobility/Exchange department.
- Original grade record, validated by your university's academic registration or audit unit. In case your university issues a record of grades in digital, please indicate that you must send this document directly to the INTEC mobility emails by institutional email.
- Graduate students must send a copy of their undergraduate degree.
- Letter of recommendation from a professor at the home university.
- Motivation letter of the student.
- Copy of valid passport.
- Curriculum vitae.
- Two (2) front photographs, size 2 x 2 inches. You MUST bring these photos on photo paper when you come to INTEC.
- Proof of Spanish (in case you belong to a non-Spanish-speaking country) or similar document agreed between the university/institution of origin and the Directorate of Institutional Mobility.
- Medical insurance valid for your stay in the Dominican Republic. The insurance must include, but not limit, coverage for medical expenses of at least USD 10,000.00 or its equivalent with coverage for medications, transfers, outpatient treatment, hospital treatment, repatriation to country of origin, among others.
- Any other document requested according to the mobility stay to be applied.
- In case of applying through free mobility, meaning that you must make the corresponding payments, please validate the cost for foreign students through this link ([undergraduate and postgraduate](#)).

STUDY ABROAD IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC FOR STUDENTS

Academic mobility is one of the strategies that institutions of higher education provides in order to allow students, teachers and administrative staff a great experience in an international academic environment. The interaction with different educational and cultural systems offers intellectual enrichment and broaden their horizons to be a global citizen. This study abroad program has a duration of 1 to 4 weeks and a minimum of 20 participants per program. Program cost varies according to need, for more details contact the mobility office.



CLINICAL EXCHANGE PROGRAM

This program seeks to offer a study abroad opportunity for United States (US) medical students, in which they will be exposed to the Dominican Republic (DR) health system and practices.

Program description

Having an integrated design and a hands-on approach, the structure of this exchange program allows the student to experience the basic rules and procedures of the Dominican Healthcare system can have a collaborative educational experience that involves patient care in Public Hospitals while also learning about the prevalent diseases in this country.

Benefits for participants

Promotes awareness of the necessary skills to work in public hospitals in a developing country. Promotes values such as solidarity, responsibility, and interest in social activities. Possibility of returning to DR for a longer exchange period.

Methodology

The proposed program is a 1-week exchange because this allows US partner universities the flexibility to come without having to take too much time from their university schedule a study time.

INMERSION PROGRAMS MODELS AT INTEC

Program description

Internationalization is a highly important aspect of our world. By merging theoretical classes and field practices in a developing country, students from all over the world can obtain not only the experience of a lifetime but can also gain new and different perspectives in regards to their respective field of interest.

CULTURAL IMMERSION PROGRAM

Program description

This program offers international students, in addition to creditable courses, the opportunity to know and experience the cultural structure of the Dominican Republic, interconnected with Spanish courses so they can have a better understanding of the Dominican culture and its people.

Benefits for participants

Allows the students and faculty to know the rich history and culture of the Dominican Republic. Improved Spanish language skills by exposing participants to real situations and to a colloquial use of the language. Encourages international teamwork. Possibility of returning to DR for a longer exchange period.

HUMANISTIC AND SOCIAL PROFILE ASPECTS OF THE ECOSYSTEMS OF THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC

Program description

The main objective of this program is to analyze the origins of Dominican culture and the ways that it has been used as a reference to transcend as a unique nation, through our generations. During this program, student will have a better understanding of the diversity of cultures present in the Dominican Republic since its foundation.

Benefits for participants

Encourages interaction with the various natural resources and environments available in the Dominican Republic. Improved Spanish language skills by exposing participants to real situations and to a colloquial use of the language. Encourages international teamwork. Possibility of returning to DR for a longer exchange period.

CULTURAL AND ENGINEERING: DOMINICAN EXPERIENCE

Program description

This program has been designed with an integrated approach in which the student while learning about the culture of the Dominican Republic can have a firsthand experience of the level of quality in the industrial system. In this 11-week exchange, cultural visits to national monuments and research project at specific industrial and mechanical industries are included.

Benefits for participants

Encourages international teamwork (among international students participating in the exchange program and students from INTEC). Promotes awareness of the necessary skills to work in industries in a developing country. Increases ability to manage challenges from different cultures and socioeconomic backgrounds. Improves Spanish language skills. Possibility of returning to DR for a longer exchange period.



MICROFINANCE IMMERSION PROGRAM IN THE DOMINICAN REPUBLIC



Program description

The program involves conducting field research with a microfinance partner in the DR, taking classes in social enterprises led by the faculty of the visiting and hosting universities. This social enterprise field research experience allows students to apply the lessons learned in the classroom to real world social problems like extreme poverty in partnership with local institutions.

Benefits for participants

Studies consumer behavior in the Dominican Republic with a partnered organization. Assignments are led by INTEC Faculty and accompanied by INTEC students, encouraging teamwork. Participation in structured site visits in the country. Improves Spanish language skills. Possibility of returning to DR for a longer exchange period.

Methodology

Each day will be developed in a participatory, creative and critical/reflexive environment in which the students can discuss their experiences in the Dominican Republic. Assessments are held through daily practices on the topic of choice. From the outset of the program, the student must have a reflective journal to report their ideas and experiences and as a way to see the development and improvement of their knowledge.
